“The temperature is different... some like warm and some like cold- *Jessica*”

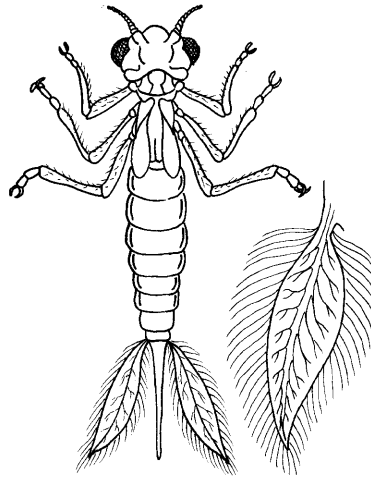

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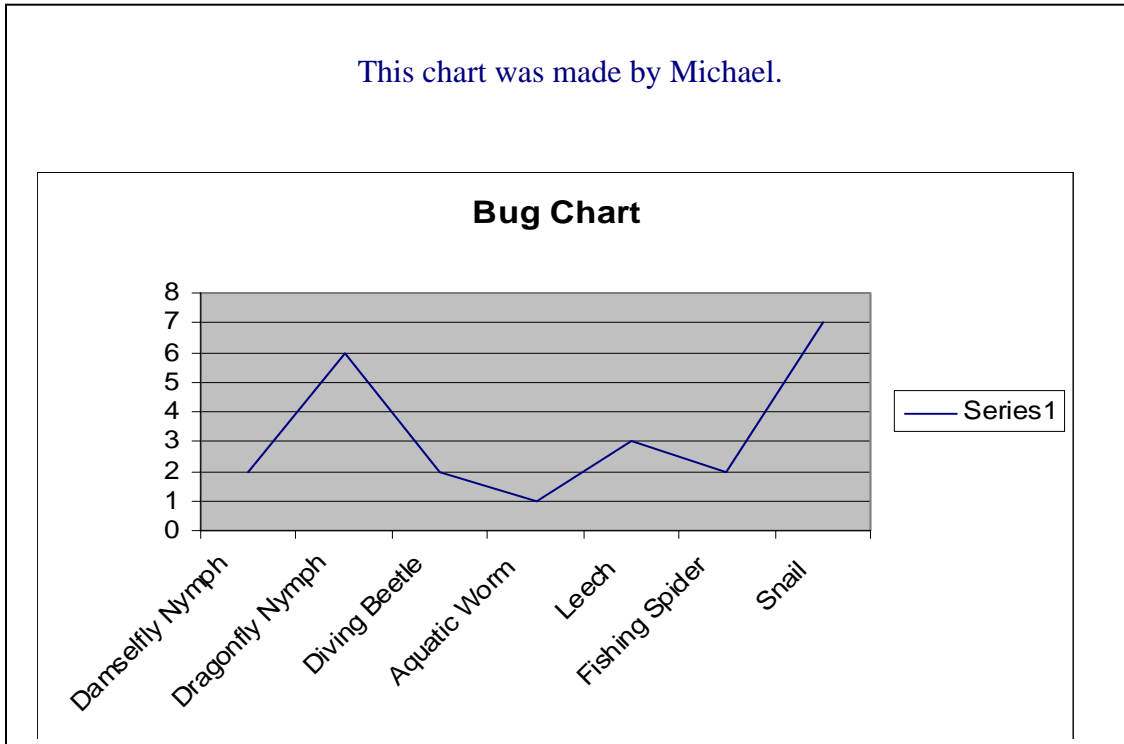
Damselfly Nymph

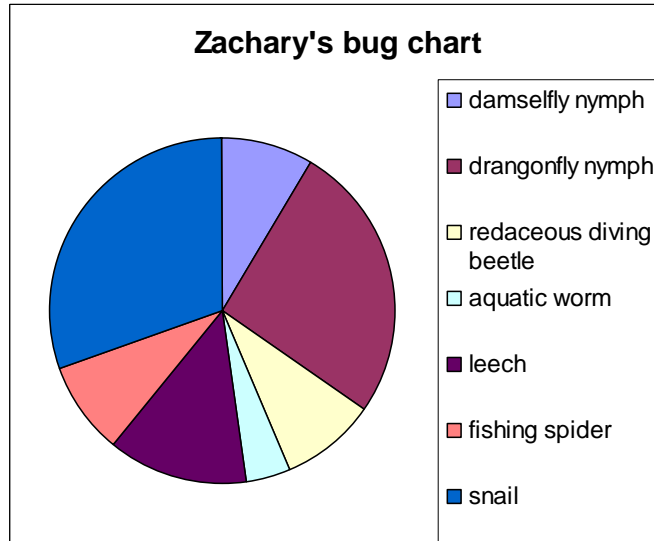
Here are our results
