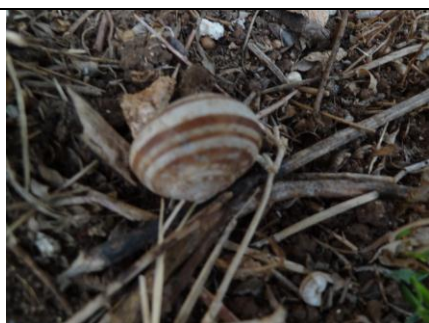

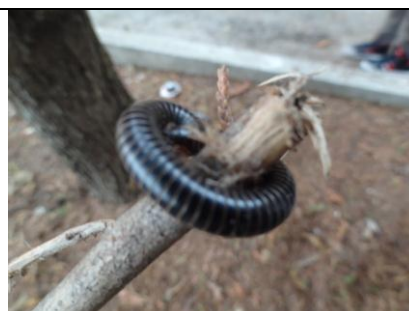
We are very happy and proud of our scientific explorations in the middle school. We are still studying biology and we are learning a lot about plants and animals in our garden.
